Travel Itinerary

DAY 1

Tuesday, October 31 – New York City, NY

Depart New York City NY from JFK, Continue to Tel Aviv, Israel.

DAY 2

Wednesday, November 1 – Tel Aviv, Israel

Our guides and buses will meet us at the airport to transport us to our hotel for dinner.

Dinner and overnight stay

DAY 3

Thursday, November 2 – Mount of Olives/Palm Sunday Path/Garden of Gethsemane/Kidron Valley/Pool of Siloam/Bethlehem/Shepards' Fields/Shopping

Drive to the Mount of Olives for a wonderful view of Jerusalem and walk the Palm Sunday road. See the Garden of Gethsemane at the foot of the hill, with its ancient olive trees and the Church of All Nations. Walk down through the Kidron Valley and see the tomb of Absalom—the wicked son of David, the tomb of Zachariah the prophet, the tomb of Jehoshaphat. Head to Bethlehem and have lunch, visit the Shepards' Fields.

DAY 4

Friday, November 3 – Temple Mount/Rabbinical Tunnel/St. Anne's Church/Pool of Bethesda/Western Wall/Davidson Center/Southern Steps/Etzion Sound and Light

Experience the Temple Mount – the place where God told Abraham to offer his son Isaac on an altar, where the Dome of the Rock now stands. We will venture into the Rabbinical Tunnel where we view Jerusalem as it was 2,000 years ago. There are huge stones placed by Herod the Great prior to the time of Jesus. Visit the Southern Steps of the Temple Mount and the Davidson Center to learn the history of the nation of Israel. Then we will travel to Gush Etzion in the West Bank area to see the sound and light show.

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DAY 5

Saturday, November 4 – Massada/Ein Gedi/Dead Sea/Qumran

Travel to Masada and ascend the ancient fortress by cable car to explore the ruins where, from 70-73AD Jewish defenders made the last stand of the Judean revolt against Rome. View Ein Gedi, have lunch and then continue south to the lowest point on earth to experience the Dead Sea. Visit Qumran.

DAY 6

Sunday, November 5 – Israel Museum/Yad Vashem (Holocaust Museum)/Old City of David

Head to the Israel Museum to see the Second Temple Model and view the Dead Sea Scrolls. At Yad Vashem we'll learn about the worst tragedy that has ever happened in history to the Jewish people during the Holocaust period. Visit the City of David including a 3D movie.

DAY 7

Monday, November 6 – Temple Institute/Upper Room/Tomb of David/Jewish Quarter/Cardo Broadwall/Garden Tomb/Endtime Prophecy Conference

Tour the Temple Institute and view first-hand the preparations made by the Jewish people in anticipation of their third temple. Go to the Jewish Quarter including the Cardo and Broadwall. Experience the Upper Room where God's Spirit was poured out on the day of Pentecost. See the tomb of David. Visit the Garden Tomb where many believe Jesus was buried. We are excited to announce our fifth annual Endtime Prophecy Conference in Israel at the Pavilion, in the building where the Jerusalem Prophecy College is located.

Dinner and overnight stay

DAY 8

Tuesday, November 7 – Joppa/Carmel/Haifa

Our group will depart from Jerusalem, travel to Joppa and visit Simon the Tanner's house. Experience Mt. Carmel where the prophet Elijah faced off the prophets of Baal and pulled down fire from heaven that consumed the water and the sacrifice. Travel to Haifa and visit Ram Bam, the world's largest underground hospital. View the Port of Haifa.

DAY 9

Wednesday, November 8– Boat Ride–Sea of Galilee/Ancient Boat/Mt of Beatitudes/Capernaum/Yardenit Baptismal Site

Take a ride in the Jesus Boat on the Sea of Galilee, where Jesus and Peter walked on the water. View the Ancient Boat dating back to 1st century AD. Visit the Mount of Beatitudes where the Sermon on the Mount was delivered. Then visit Capernaum where we'll see an ancient synagogue and St. Peter's house, which was later converted to a church. And for the top highlight of the whole trip, we will have our baptisms in the Jordan River. Life Changing!!

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DAY 10

Thursday, November 9 – Upper Galilee/Tel Dan-Abraham's Gate/Banias/Golan Heights/Mt. Bental Syrian Overview

Visit the area in Upper Galilee. Tel Dan is one of the most important sites for archaeological and historical recovery of ancient Israel. The city of Dan represented the northern border of the Biblical Kingdom of Israel. It was here, 2,900 years ago, that King Hazael of Damascus punctuated his invasion of Israelite territory with the erection of the famous House of David inscription, the oldest document to mention the historical King David. Continue onto Banās, formerly Caesarea Philippi, where Peter said, “Thou art the Christ.” View the Golan Heights and see an overview of Syria.

DAY 11

Friday, November 10 – Bet She'an/Megiddo/Cana/Nazareth/Dinner in Tiberias/Transfer to airport in evening

Stand in Bet She'an where Saul and Jonathan were nailed to a wall after they were killed in battle. Make our way to Megiddo to see the excavations of one of Solomon’s chariot cities and the Plain of Armageddon. View Cana where Jesus performed his first miracle and Nazareth where he was raised. We will finally complete our trip by having dinner at The Pagoda (in Tiberias). Transfer to the airport in the evening.

DAY 12

Saturday, November 11 – Flying from Tel Aviv to New York City
