Travel Itinerary

DAY 1

Wednesday May 1 – Jamaica, NY Depart Jamaica NY from JFK, continue to Zurich Switzerland and continue to Tel Aviv, Israel.

<u>DAY 2</u>

Thursday, May 2 – Tel Aviv, Israel

Our guides and buses will meet us at the airport to transport us to our hotel for dinner. *Dinner and overnight stay*

<u>DAY 3</u>

Friday, May 3 – Mount of Olives/Palm Sunday Path/Garden of Gethsemane/Kidron Valley/ Bethlehem/Shepard's' Fields/Shopping

Drive to the Mount of Olives for a wonderful view of Jerusalem and walk the Palm Sunday Road. See the Garden of Gethsemane at the foot of the hill, with its ancient olive trees and the Church of All Nations. Walk down through the Kidron Valley and see the tomb of Absalom–the wicked son of David, the tomb of Zachariah the prophet, the tomb of Jehoshaphat. Head to Bethlehem and have lunch, visit the Shepard's' Fields. *Dinner and overnight stay*

<u>DAY 4</u>

Saturday, May 4 - Masada/Ein Gedi/Qumran/Dead Sea

Travel to Masada and ascend the ancient fortress by cable car to explore the ruins where, from 70-73AD Jewish defenders made the last stand of the Judean revolt against Rome. View Ein Gedi. Visit Qumran, have lunch and then continue south to the lowest point on earth to experience the Dead Sea.

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<u>DAY 5</u>

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Sunday, May 5 – Temple Mount/St. Anne's Church/Pool of Bethesda/Western Wall/Rabbinical Tunnel/Southern Steps/Etzion Sound and Light

Experience the Temple Mount – the place where God told Abraham to offer his son Isaac on an altar, where the Dome of the Rock now stands. We will venture into the Rabbinical Tunnel where we view Jerusalem as it was 2,000 years ago. There are huge stones placed by Herod the Great prior to the time of Jesus. Visit the Southern Steps of the Temple Mount. Then we will travel to Gush Etzion in the West Bank area to see the sound and light show *Dinner and overnight stay*

<u>DAY 6</u>

Monday, May 6 – Jewish Agency Absorption Center/Yad Vashem (Holocaust Museum)/JPC Visit

Visit the Jewish Agency Absorption Center that is partnering with the Israeli Government to help Jews navigate into the culture once they make Aliyah. Head to Yad Vashem we'll learn about the worst tragedy that has ever happened in history to the Jewish people.

<u>DAY 7</u>

Tuesday, May 7 – Temple Institute/Upper Room/Tomb of David/Jewish Quarter/Cardo Broadwall/Old City of David/Garden Tomb

Tour the Temple Institute and view first-hand the preparations made by the Jewish people in anticipation of their third temple. Go to the Jewish Quarter including the Cardo and Broadwall. Experience the Upper Room where God's Spirit was poured out on the day of Pentecost. See the tomb of David. Visit the City of David including a 3D movie. Visit the Garden Tomb where many believe Jesus was buried.

<u>DAY 8</u>

Wednesday, May 8 – Joppa/Caesarea By the Sea/Carmel/Tiberias

Our group will depart from Jerusalem and travel to visit Joppa and Simon the Tanner's house. Stop at Caesarea by the Sea and experience an amphitheater from Roman times, possibly the actual place where Paul stood before Festus, Felix and Agrippa. Experience Mt. Carmel where the prophet Elijah faced off the prophets of Baal and pulled down fire from heaven that consumed the water and the sacrifice.

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<u>DAY 9</u>

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Thursday, May 9 – Boat Ride–Sea of Galilee/Ancient Boat/Mt of Beatitudes/Capernaum/Yardenit Baptismal Site/Farewell Dinner

Take a ride in the Jesus Boat on the Sea of Galilee, where Jesus and Peter walked on the water. View the Ancient Boat dating back to 1st century AD. Visit the Mount of Beatitudes where the Sermon on the Mount was delivered. Then visit Capernaum where we'll see an ancient synagogue and Peter's house, which was later converted to a church. And for the top highlight of the whole trip, we will have our baptisms in the Jordan River. Life Changing!! We will celebrate our trip by having dinner at The Decks (in Tiberias).

<u>DAY 10</u>

Friday, May 10 – Upper Galilee/Tel Dan-Abraham's Gate/Banias/Golan Heights/Mt. Bental Syrian Overview

Visit the area in Upper Galilee. Tel Dan is one of the most important sites for archaeological and historical recovery of ancient Israel. The city of Dan represented the northern border of the Biblical Kingdom of Israel. It was here, 2,900 years ago, that King Hazael of Damascus punctuated his invasion of Israelite territory with the erection of the famous House of David inscription, the oldest document to mention the historical King David. Continue onto Banās, formerly Caesarea Philippi, where Peter said, "Thou art the Christ." View the Golan Heights and see an overview of Syria. *Dinner and overnight stay*

DAY 11

Saturday, May 11 – Bet She'an/Megiddo/Transfer to Jordan/Jerash/Jabbock/Petra Overnight

Stand in Bet She'an where Saul and Jonathan were nailed to a wall after they were killed in battle. Make our way to Megiddo to see the excavations of one of Solomon's chariot cities and the Plain of Armageddon. Leave Israel and cross the Israel/Jordan border. View the mountains of Gilead and Visit the ancient city of Jerash. Driving along the way cross River Jabbock where Jacob wrestled with the angel and changed his name from Jacob to Israel. It has been said to be the best-preserved Roman ruins outside of Italy. It is believed that Paul travelled through this city on his way to Damascus. Arrive and spend the night in Petra. *Dinner and overnight stay*

DAY 12

Sunday, May 12 - Petra

Petra... Also known as the "eighth wonder of the world." This entire city of rose-colored temples and amphitheaters is carved from the multi-hued rock cliffs which surround its hidden valley. Herod the Great's family originated from. This city. Enter the city through a narrow passage, surrounded by colorful and beautiful 300 ft cliffs, and it is about 140 feet high and 90 feet wide. See the Amphitheatre, city center, and the Monastery. *Dinner and overnight stay*

DAY 13

Monday, May 13 - Mt Nebo/Madaba/Amman

Leave this morning to Mt. Nebo where Moses viewed the promised land and died and buried, and you will have a great view of the land of Israel. Visit the ruins of the 4th and 6th century church whose floor is still covered with marvelous mosaics, which was excavated in 1933. On to Madaba and see the 4th century mosaic map of Jerusalem during the period of Herod. Early Dinner before heading to the airport. *Dinner*

<u>DAY 14</u>

Tuesday, May 14 – Early Morning Flying from Amman Jordan/Layover in Frankfurt Germany/JFK
