Travel Itinerary

DAY 1

Monday, November 9 – Newark, NJ

Depart Newark NJ from EWR, Continue to Tel Aviv, Israel.

DAY 2

Tuesday, November 10 – Tel Aviv, Israel/Ancient Shilo/Red Heifers.

Our guides and buses will meet us at the airport. We will go to Ancient Shilo national park and see the red heifers and the tabernacle spot. Transport us to our hotel for dinner.

DAY 3

Wednesday, November 11 – Mount of Olives/Palm Sunday Path/Garden of Gethsemane/Kidron Valley/Pool of Siloam/Pilgrims Road/Southern Steps/Bethlehem/Shepard's' Fields/Shopping

Drive to the Mount of Olives for a wonderful view of Jerusalem and walk the Palm Sunday Road. See the Garden of Gethsemane at the foot of the hill, with its ancient olive trees and the Church of All Nations. Walk down through the Kidron Valley and see the tomb of Absalom—the wicked son of David, the tomb of Zachariah the prophet, the tomb of Jehoshaphat. Visit the pool of Siloam where Jesus healed a blind man. Walk up the Pilgrimage Road and experience a 2,000 year old road that leads up to the Temple Mount. Visit the Southern Steps of the Temple Mount to learn the history of the nation of Israel. Head to Bethlehem and have lunch and shopping. Visit the Shepard's' Fields.

DAY 4

Thursday, November 12 – Temple Mount/St. Anne's Church/Pool of Bethesda/Western Wall/Rabbinical Tunnel/Etzion Sound and Light

Experience the Temple Mount – the place where God told Abraham to offer his son Isaac on an altar, where the Dome of the Rock now stands. We will venture into the Rabbinical Tunnel where we view Jerusalem as it was 2,000 years ago. There are huge stones placed by Herod the Great prior to the time of Jesus. Then we will travel to Gush Etzion in the West Bank area to see the sound and light show

DAY 5

Friday, November 13 – Jewish Agency Absorption Center/Israel Museum

Visit the Jewish Agency Absorption Center that is partnering with the Israeli Government to help Jews navigate into the culture once they make Aliyah. At the Israel Museum see a life size model of the third temple as well as art and archaeology and the dead sea scrolls.

DAY 6

Saturday, November 14 – Masada/Ein Gedi/Qumran/Dead Sea

Travel to Masada and ascend the ancient fortress by cable car to explore the ruins where, from 70-73AD Jewish defenders made the last stand of the Judean revolt against Rome. View Ein Gedi. Visit Qumran, have lunch and then continue south to the lowest point on earth to experience the Dead Sea.

DAY 7

Sunday, November 15 – Upper Room/Tomb of David/ Jewish Quarter/Cardo Broadwall/Temple Institute/Old City of David/Garden Tomb/Jerusalem Prophecy College

Experience the Upper Room where God's Spirit was poured out on the day of Pentecost. See the tomb of David. Go to the Jewish Quarter including the Cardo and Broad wall. Tour the Temple Institute and view first-hand the preparations made by the Jewish people in anticipation of their third temple. Visit the City of David including a 3D movie. Visit the Garden Tomb where many believe Jesus was buried. Go to the Jerusalem Prophecy College after dinner.

DAY 8

Monday, November 16 – Joppa/Caesarea By the Sea/Carmel/Capernaum

Our group will depart from Jerusalem and travel to visit Joppa and Simon the Tanner's house. Stop at Caesarea by the Sea and experience an amphitheater from Roman times, possibly the actual place where Paul stood before Festus, Felix and Agrippa. Experience Mt. Carmel where the prophet Elijah faced off the prophets of Baal and pulled down fire from heaven that consumed the water and the sacrifice. Head to the hotel in Capernaum

DAY 9

Tuesday, November 17 – Boat Ride–Sea of Galilee/Ancient Boat/Mt of Beatitudes/Capernaum/Yardenit Baptismal Site/Farewell Dinner

Take a ride in the Jesus Boat on the Sea of Galilee, where Jesus and Peter walked on the water. View the Ancient Boat dating back to 1st century AD. Visit the Mount of Beatitudes where the Sermon on the Mount was delivered. Then visit Capernaum where we'll see an ancient synagogue and Peter's house, which was later converted to a church. And for the top highlight of the whole trip, we will have our baptisms in the Jordan River. Life Changing!! We will celebrate our trip by having dinner at The Decks (in Tiberias).

DAY 10

Wednesday, November 18 – Upper Galilee/Tel Dan-Abraham's Gate/Banias/Golan Heights/Mt. Bental Syrian Overview/Olive Factory

Visit the area in Upper Galilee. Tel Dan is one of the most important sites for archaeological and historical recovery of ancient Israel. The city of Dan represented the northern border of the Biblical Kingdom of Israel. It was here, 2,900 years ago, that King Hazael of Damascus punctuated his invasion of Israelite territory with the erection of the famous House of David inscription, the oldest document to mention the historical King David. Continue onto Banās, formerly Caesarea Philippi, where Peter said, "Thou art the Christ." View the Golan Heights and see an overview of Syria. We will visit an Olive Factory that will be the Cherry on Top of the day.

Dinner and overnight stay

DAY 11

Thursday, November 19 – Bet She'an/Megiddo

Stand in Bet She'an where Saul and Jonathan were nailed to a wall after they were killed in battle. Make our way to Megiddo to see the excavations of one of Solomon's chariot cities and the Plain of Armageddon. Early Dinner before heading to the airport for late evening flight.
